

Linda Schulman Innovation Grants 2012 Call for Proposals

The Linda Schulman Innovation Awards program supports projects that promote English language learning and embody a spirit of creativity, sensitivity and community. Grants of \$500 to \$1,000 will fund pedagogical projects to benefit English language learners by improving their language skills or increasing their understanding of American culture. We are currently accepting proposals for the 2012-2013 school year. All teachers of English as a second language in a K-12 school, a college, or an adult education program in the state of Massachusetts are encouraged to apply for these grants.

Project proposals, a current CV (résumé), and a letter of support from a supervisor or administrator should be sent by email to info@lsi-award.org by March 2, 2012. The proposal should include:

- project director's name, email address, surface mail address, and phone number
- project director's current teaching position
- project title, project description and expected outcomes
- proposed time frame of project, including preparation time and expected date of project completion
- project budget
- the name and address of the person or office in their institution or school system to which successful applicants' grant checks should be sent.

Grant recipients will be expected to produce a written report when the project is completed, share with MATSOL members any materials produced with grant funds, and serve as mentors to future applicants.
