- Oversee new student enrollment in Schoology.
- Monitor courses during the semester to ensure that teachers are grading assignments in a timely manner.
- Oversee course beginning, ending, and archiving.
- Deliver webinar for onboarding new instructors; create help document for instructors with links to Schoology support information.
